

## Multi-point flowing Skirt Pattern



Need:

- 14 + oz yarn (I used Caron Simply Soft 4 ply) (amount depends on length and size of skirt)
- G Hook

Start:

Chain length needed for your waist. Needs to be in a multiple of 2.

My skirt is a size 14. I started with a ch 120. Sl st to first ch to make a circle.

**Rnd 1:** ch 1, sc in same ch from hook, sc around, sl st to 1 sc. (should have same number of sc as starting chain)

**Rnd 2:** ch 3 (counts as 1<sup>st</sup> dc here and throughout), dc in each sc around, sl st to first dc.

**Rnd 3:** ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 1, \* dc in next 2 dc, ch 1\* around, sl st to first dc (This is your row for ribbon to weave in to)

**Rnd 4:** ch 3, dc in next dc , dc in ch 1 space, \* dc in next 2 dc, dc in ch 1 space\* around, sl st to first dc

**Rnd 5 – 14 (10 rows):** sl st in first dc, ch3, dc in the last sl st (created a V stitch), \* skip next dc, dc in next dc, dc in skipped dc (created V stitch) \* around, sl st to first ch 3

**Rnd 15:** \*ch 3, skip next dc, sl st in next dc\* around (should have (starting chain/2) ch3 loops)

**Rnd 16:** sl st in first ch 3 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch 3 space, \*(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch 3 space\* around, sl st to first ch 3

**Rnd 17:** sl st in next dc, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch 2 space, dc in next dc, \* sk 2 dc, dc in next dc, (2dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch 2 space, dc in next dc \* around, sl st to first ch 3

**Rnd 18:** sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next st, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch 2 space, dc in next two dc, \*skip 2 dc, dc in next two dc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch 2 space, dc in next two dc \* around, sl st to first ch 3

**V-Stitch Row:** sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in each dc until ch 2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch 2 space, dc in each dc except last in row, \*skip 2 dc, dc in each dc until ch 2 space, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch 2 space, dc in each dc except last in row\* around, sl st to first ch 3

**Shell Row:** sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in each dc until ch 2 space, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch 2 space, dc in each dc except last in row, \*skip 2 dc, dc in each dc until ch 2 space, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch 2 space, dc in each dc except last in row\* around, sl st to first ch 3 space.

**Space Row:** sl st in next dc, ch 4, skip the next dc, dc in next dc, (ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc) until reach last dc of row, \*skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, (ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc) until ch 2 space, (ch 1, dc, ch 2, dc, ch 1) in ch 2 space, dc in first dc, (ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc) until reach last dc of row \* around, sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch in first ch 4

**Rnd 19:** V-stitch

**Rnd 20:** Shell

**Rows 21 and on** are in the following pattern: Space, V-stitch, Shell, Space, V-stitch, Shell, etc...

When skirt is the desired length, finish off yarn. Weave a ribbon through row 3
